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Senior Ladies' Quadrangular – Competition Rules

22-25 September 2014

Golf Club Punta Ala – Italy

The full text for some conditions may be found in the current English edition of the Rules of golf on the pages as indicated.

Competition

Match Play Team Competition. Each team consists of 16 players. A team may bring up to 18 players, but must decide before the start of the competition who is playing each day. A reserve (for a player unable to play on the day) must be brought in at least 20 minutes before the start of the competition each day.
Participants: Italy, Austria, Germany, Switzerland,

Players must be 50 years old on first day of competition

Players must be amateurs as defined by the rules of Amateur Status as approved by R&A Rules Limited. All players have to pay the full price, even if not playing every day.

Handicap

Handicaps are limited to 24,0 EGA exact. Any player with a higher handicap has to start with 24,0.

Handicap Allowances

Single: $\frac{3}{4}$ difference between playing handicaps

Greensome: full difference between total of playing handicaps (60% of lower hcp, 40% of higher hcp)

Four Ball: lowest player is scratch, higher handicaps receive 90% of the difference between playing handicaps.

Conditions of play

The conditions of play shall conform to the rules of golf as published by The R&A Rules Limited and the Local Rules, established by the Tournament Director.

Time of Starting

Rule 6-3°. Penalty: arriving within 5 minutes after the starting time = loss of 1st hole, beyond the = disqualification.

Advice

Rule 8-1. A Player may only give advice to or ask for advice from his partner

Rule 33-1. Each team is allowed to appoint a team Captain who may give advice to members of that team. The appointed Captain must be identified to the Tournament Director prior to the start of the tournament and must be an Amateur as defined by the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by the R&A Rules Limited.

Penalty for breach of any of the above conditions: disqualification

Caddie (Penalty: See penalty statement on page 139/140 of the rules of golf)
No caddies will be allowed with exception of team members and team Captains.

Buggies

There are 20 buggies available, 5 for each team.

Distance measuring devices

Players are allowed to use distance measuring devices, measuring only distance (and not other items such as wind, slope, altitude and temperature). Mobile phones, used as phones, are not allowed on the course. Penalty: loss of hole.

Etiquette

Players shall at all times refrain from showing any extravagant emotion or committing any action that can be regarded as unacceptable by the tournament Committee and/or other players. The Tournament Committee may impose a penalty of disqualification under Rule 33-7 if the Committee considers a player guilty of a serious breach of Etiquette.

Slow play

The maximum time allowed will be determined by the tournament director and will be published on the official notice board. The first group is out of position when they are behind the schedule. For subsequent groups, out of position is defined as being more than the starting interval behind the group in front and behind schedule.

In absence of mitigating circumstances, a group is liable to be timed if it is out of position.

From the commencement of timing, if any player exceeds

- 50 seconds on a "first to play approach shot (including Par 3 tee shot), chip o putt, or
 - 40 seconds if it is a tee shot or second or third to play shot,
- he is deemed to have had a bad time.

A player whose group is timed will have a bad time carried forward in the round even if the group subsequently arrives back in position or within time.

Penalty for breach Matchplay

1 bad time	Verbal warning from official
2 bad times	Loss of hole
3 bad times	Disqualification

Suspension of Play due to a dangerous situation (Note to R 6-8b)

The signal for the suspension of play due to a dangerous situation will be:

Discontinue Play Immediately :	One short signal
Resume Play:	Two short signals

Form of Play

The competition will be played in three rounds over 18 holes, match play, so that each country can play against the three others, according to the previous year placing. (2013: 1st Switzerland, 2nd Germany, 3rd Austria, 4th Italy)

2nd Day	Country	A vs C	B vs D
3rd Day	Country	A vs D	B vs C

Per match, three points are awarded (1 for the front nine, 1 for the back nine, 1 for the match). In case of a tie both sides will receive half a point (for the front nine, etc.). Maximum win per match is three points. All players (winners) are required to put down the result for the front nine, the back nine and for the match and to sign the result sheet after completion of their match.

Any team winning on the day will get two points and in case of a tie both sides will receive one point. The winner of the Quadrangular will be the team with the most points.

In the event of a tie between two teams, the winner will be decided as follows:

1. the match between the two teams
2. the team with the most individual points during the whole Quadrangular
3. aggregate of the ups in individual matches
4. aggregate of the downs in individual matches

In the event of a tie between three teams, the winner will be decided as follows:

1. the team with the most individual points during the whole Quadrangular
2. aggregate of the ups in individual matches
3. aggregate of the downs in individual matches

Order of matches (better hcps ahead):

Each player has to play at least ONE Fourball or Greensome during the Quadrangular.

Singles are played in flights of four.

Sheets

Every match receives one result sheet from the starter. The winner must fill in this sheet when the match has been decided and has to give this to the Tournament Secretary as soon as possible.
